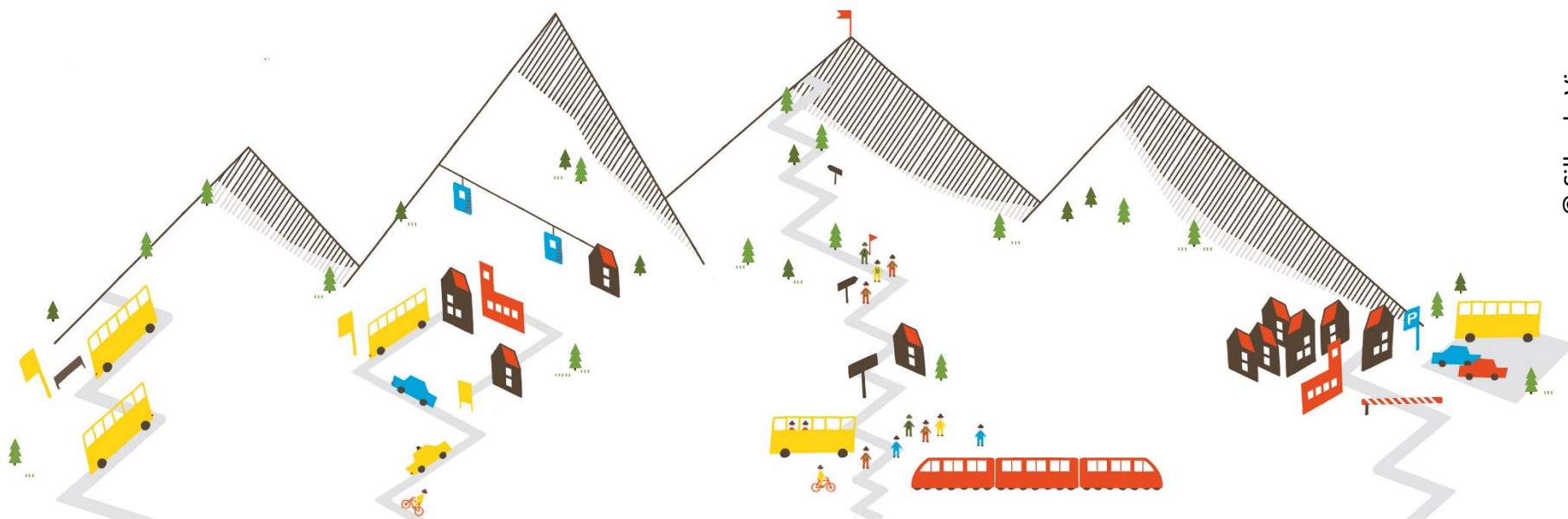

... activities during the vacation

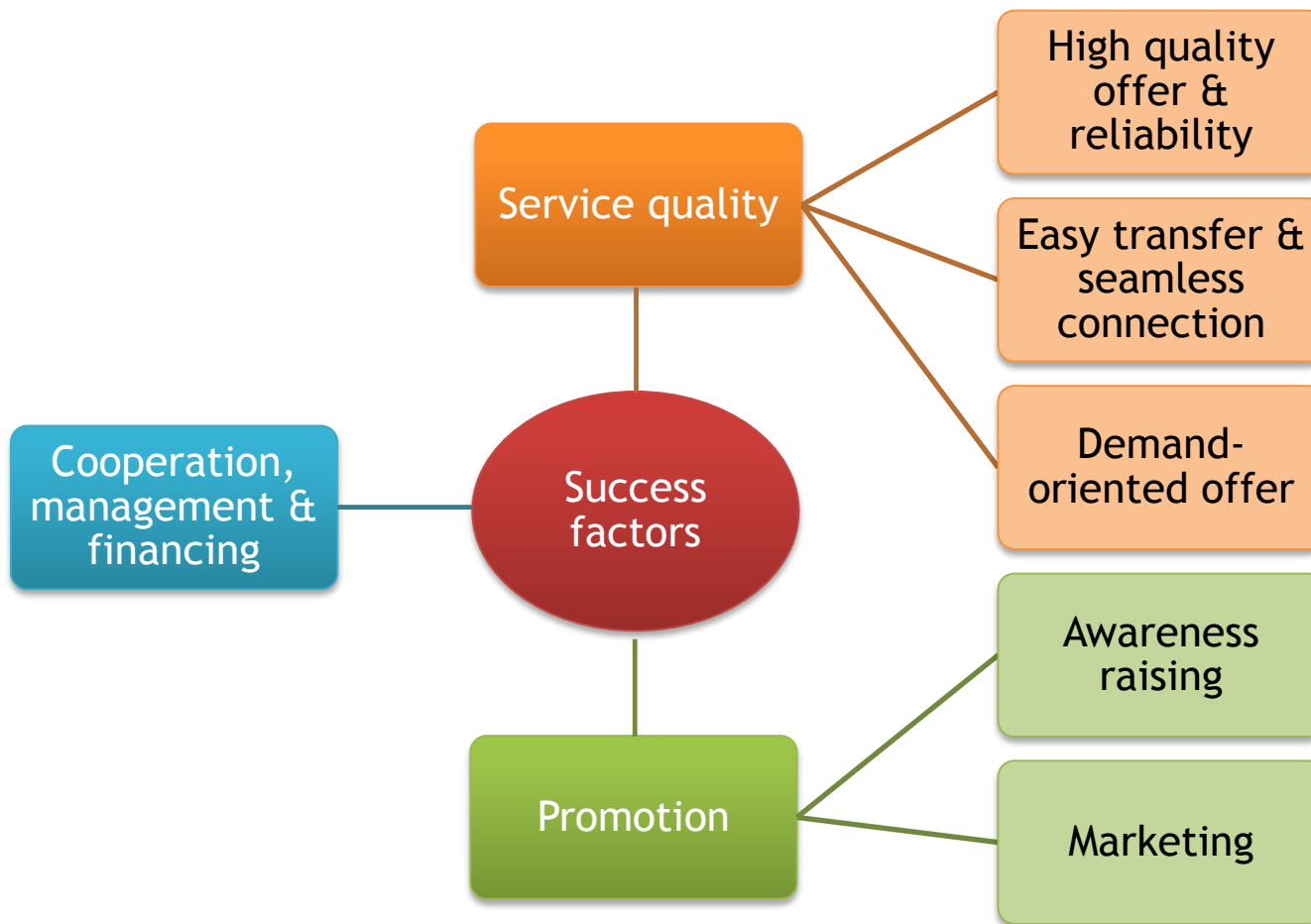

- **Mobilto (AT)** – regional transport and tourism information center
- **Gemeinden mobil (AT, I)** – mobility information centers in 63 municipal offices

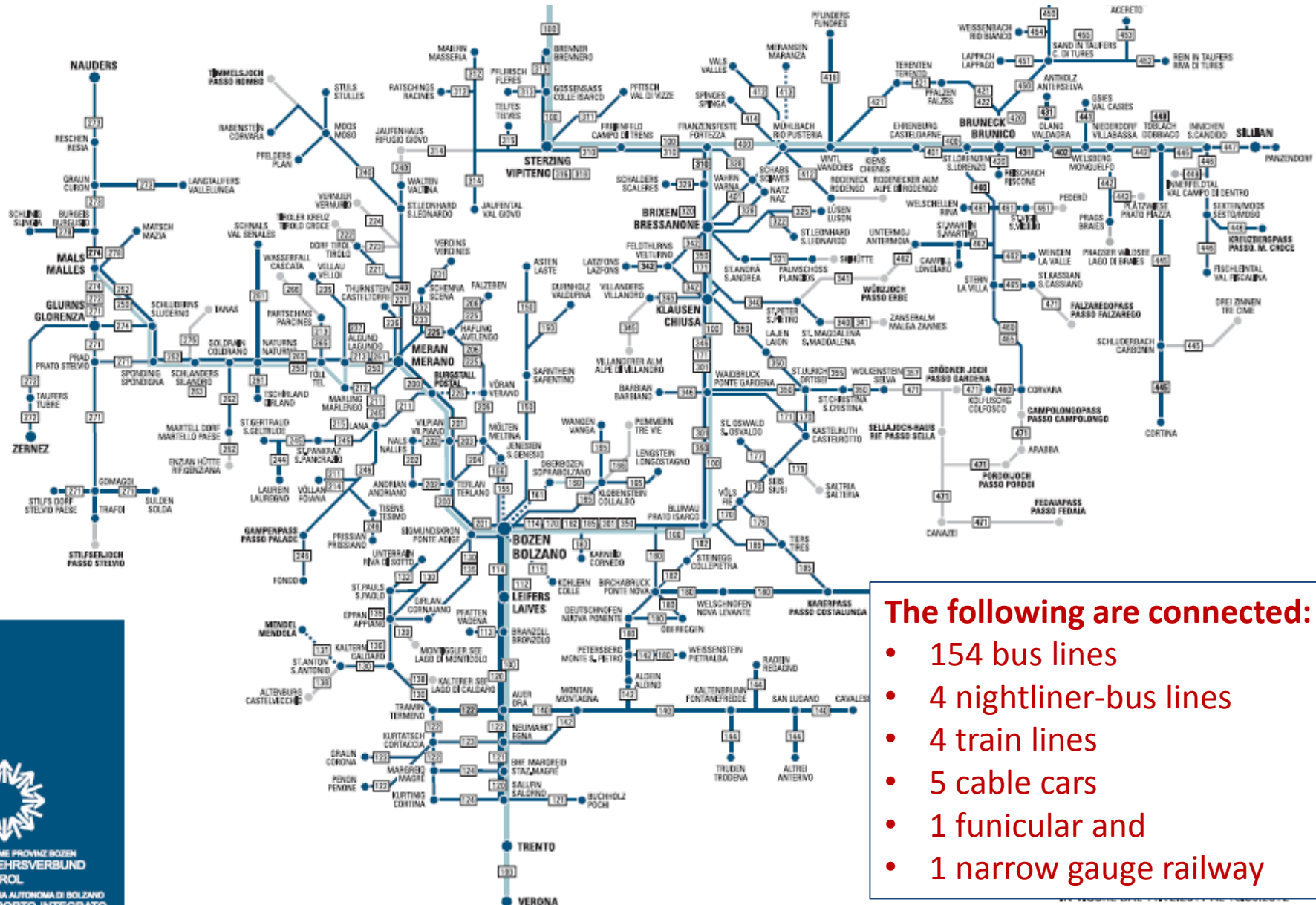


- **Fahrtziel Natur (DE, AT, CH)** – making 20 nature parks accessible by train
- **Dolomiti-Express (IT)** – seasonal train connection improving access to the skiing area from a major city
- **Engadine-Meran Route Express (CH-IT)** – Cross-border bus-train connection with bike transport option
- **Nature Park Adamello Brenta (IT)** – collective transport network – shuttles (incl. bike racks) at park periphery, from train station to park valleys



Südtirol Takt

South Tyrol wide public transport system



- The following are connected:**
- 154 bus lines
 - 4 nightliner-bus lines
 - 4 train lines
 - 5 cable cars
 - 1 funicular and
 - 1 narrow gauge railway



MobilCard

One ticket for all means of transport in South Tyrol for 1, 3 or 7 days



museumobil Card

One ticket for all means of transport in South Tyrol + entrance to 80 museums



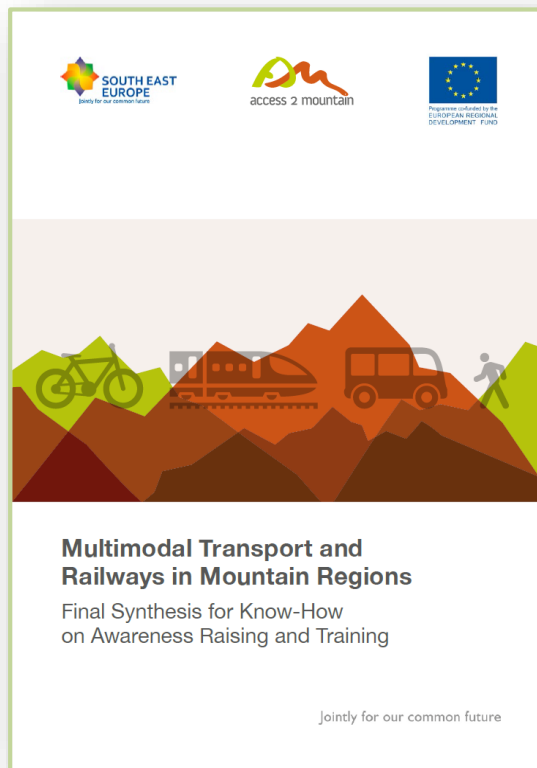
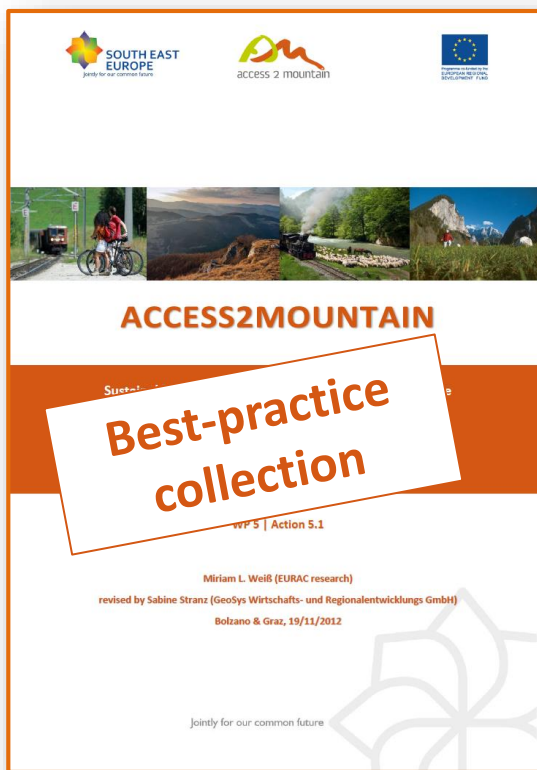
bikemobil Card
